The email must be sent from the Principal Investigator's institutional email address, with a copy to the institution's administrative contact.

The body of the email must include:

- Proposal Title
- Name of the Principal Investigator
- Name and email address of the administrative contact

Each application must include **three files**:

File 1. Technical Proposal (PDF, max. 3 pages)

For File 2. PDF file must include:

A digitally signed document by a legal representative of the unit/institution where the project will be carried out, confirming that the institution: (a) is legally established; (b) has administrative and

financial capacity; (c) has no current sanctions; and (d) accepts the CLIMAS guidelines on ethics, equity, open data, and integrity.

For File 3. XLS file:

- Use only the template [Annex 2. Budget Format](#). This template includes a brief description of the budget by category, considering the main activities and expected outputs.

- AXIS 1: Strengthening the training of health workers to respond to climate change–related emergencies and outbreaks.
- AXIS 2: Public policies on climate change and health with an intersectional approach.
- AXIS 3: Data modeling and accessibility in climate change and health.
